METHOD OF THE COMPETITION

Rules : WTF-Competition rules and in some cases completed by the rules of Belgian Federation.

System : There will be 4 competition areas, all with electronic score board system.

Award : Individuals : medals for 1st, 2nd, 3rd

Equipment : Each contestant shall wear the trunk protector, head protector, groin guard, forearm guards, shin guards, mouthpiece before entering the contest area.

Membership : Participants must be a member of a national taekwondo federation, affiliated to the W.T.F. This membership must be proved by means of a valid federal certificate of membership at the registration.

Hall Rules : Only the competitors and their coaches have admittance to the contest areas by the registration cards. Competitors and coaches have to wear sporting shoes. One single coach for every group of five competitors has free admission with a maximum of 3 coaches per team.

Protest : Only the official coach is allowed to protest, immediately after the end of the contest.
The decision of the judge is final.

Liability : Under no circumstances the organization can be held responsible for any loss, theft, violence or damage to equipment, participants and spectators.

SPECTATORS

Spectators have to pay € 5 (euro) Entry is free for spectators until 10 years old.

METHOD OF COMPETITION

Rules : WTF-Competition rules and in some cases completed by the rules of Belgian Federation

Style form : Taegeuks and Higher

Mode :

A) Athletes shall be allowed to participate in more divisions : Individual division, pair division, team division

B) Cut-off system 1st round : all participants

2nd round : at least 50% of the participants (including participants with equal scores)

3rd round : maximum of 8 participants can qualify for this round

4th round: after equal score : between 1-2-3-4 ranking

C) Final round: 2 poomsaes with 1 minute pause.

Membership : participants must be a member of a national taekwondo federation,affiliated to the W.T.F. This membership must be proved by means of a valid federal certificate of membership at the registration.

Hall Rules : Only the competitors and their coaches have admittance to the contest areas by the registration cards. Competitors and coaches have to wear sporting shoes. One single coach for every group of five competitors has free admission with a maximum of 3 coaches per team.

Protest : Only the official coach is allowed to protest, immediately after the end of the contest.
The decision of the judge is final.
